- 1 Corinthians 2:12** Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.
- 1 Corinthians 2:13** Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.
- 1 Corinthians 2:6** Howbeit we speak wisdom among them that are perfect: yet not the wisdom of this world, nor of the princes of this world, that come to nought:
- 1 Corinthians 2:7** But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, *even* the hidden *wisdom*, which God ordained before the world unto our glory:
- 1 Corinthians 2:8** Which none of the princes of this world knew: for had they known *it*, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.

<p>Revelation 10:3 And cried with a loud voice, as <i>when</i> a lion roareth: and when he had cried, seven thunders uttered their voices.</p>	
<p>Revelation 10:4 And when the seven thunders had uttered their voices, I was about to write: and I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Seal up those things which the seven thunders uttered, and write them not.</p>	<p>Seal up: Deu 29:29; Isa 29:9-14; Da 12:8-10</p>
<p>Revelation 10:5 And the angel which I saw stand upon the sea and upon the earth lifted up his hand to heaven,</p>	
<p>Revelation 10:6 And swore by him that liveth for ever and ever, who created heaven, and the things that therein are, and the earth, and the things that therein are, and the sea, and the things which are therein, that there should be time no longer:</p>	<p>Time no longer: no more delay; compare: Da 12:7, three and one-half years; in the visions of both Daniel and John the prophecy is declared by lifting the hands to heaven and swearing by "him that liveth forever"</p>
<p>Revelation 10:7 But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound, the mystery of God should be finished, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets.</p>	<p>Mystery of God: Ro 11:24-27; Col 2:1-9; 1Co 2:6-10</p>

<p>Revelation 10:8 And the voice which I heard from heaven spake unto me again, and said, Go <i>and</i> take the little book which is open in the hand of the angel which standeth upon the sea and upon the earth.</p>	
<p>Revelation 10:9 And I went unto the angel, and said unto him, Give me the little book. And he said unto me, Take <i>it</i>, and eat it up; and it shall make thy belly bitter, but it shall be in thy mouth sweet as honey.</p>	<p>The little book; take it; and eat it up: Eze 3:1-3; 2:7-10; 1Ti 4:13-16</p>
<p>Revelation 10:10 And I took the little book out of the angel's hand, and ate it up; and it was in my mouth sweet as honey: and as soon as I had eaten it, my belly was bitter.</p>	
<p>Revelation 10:11 And he said unto me, Thou must prophesy again before many peoples, and nations, and tongues, and kings.</p>	<p>Thou must prophesy: Mt 28:18-20; Rev 14:6-8</p>
