**Ezekiel 1:1** Now it came to pass in the thirtieth year, in the fourth *month*, in the fifth day of the month, as I was among the captives by the river of Chebar, that the heavens were opened, and I saw visions of God.

**Ezekiel 1:2** In the fifth day of the month, which was the fifth year of king Jehoiachin's captivity,

What is the thirtieth year? Thirty years from what? Why is it important to Ezekiel? These answers are revealed in understanding the scope of Ezekiel and the entire Bible: "ye shall know that I am the LORD" (Ge 1:1; Joh 1:1-3; 1Jo 5:6-8; Joh 1:18; 5:39; Psa 40:7; 2Ti 2:15; 3:16-17); a must: knowing what God meant when He said it and how He said it. It is all revealed in biblical context.

<ol> <li>Ezekiel's prophetic ministry began exactly 30 years after the beginning of king Josiah's monumental 13 years of revival (background <u>2Ch 34:1-13</u>).</li> <li>But what sparked the revival? (<u>2Ch 34:14-33</u>; <u>35:1-19</u>; <u>2Ki 23:1-25</u>).</li> </ol>				
592 BC	fifth year of king Jehoiachin's captivity, ( <u>Eze 1:1-2</u> ) – Ezekiel's prophetic ministry begins.
