Jeremiah 13:1 Thus saith the LORD unto me, Go and get thee a linen girdle, and put it upon thy loins, and put it not in water.

Jeremiah 13:2 So I got a girdle according to the word of the LORD, and put *it* on my loins.

Jeremiah 13:3 And the word of the LORD came unto me the second time, saying,

Jeremiah 13:4 Take the girdle that thou hast got, which *is* upon thy loins, and arise, go to Euphrates, and hide it there in a hole of the rock.

Jeremiah 13:5 So I went, and hid it by Euphrates, as the LORD commanded me.

Jeremiah 13:6 And it came to pass after many days, that the LORD said unto me, Arise, go to Euphrates, and take the girdle from thence, which I commanded thee to hide there.

Jeremiah 13:7 Then I went to Euphrates, and digged, and took the girdle from the place where I had hid it: and, behold, the girdle was marred, it was profitable for nothing.

Jeremiah 13:8 Then the word of the LORD came unto me, saying,

Jeremiah 13:9 Thus saith the LORD, After this manner will I mar the pride of Judah, and the great pride of Jerusalem.

Jeremiah 13:10 This evil people, which refuse to hear my words, (De 18:18-19) which walk in the imagination of their heart, and walk after other gods, to serve them, and to worship them, Jeremiah 13:11 For as the girdle cleaveth to the loins of a man, so have I caused to cleave unto me the whole house of Israel and the whole house of Judah, saith the LORD; but they would not hear. (Joh 12:47-48)

Jeremiah 13:12 Therefore thou shalt speak unto them this word; Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Every bottle shall be filled with wine: and they shall say unto thee, Do we not certainly know that every bottle shall be filled with wine?

Jeremiah 13:13 Then shalt thou say unto them, Thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will fill all the inhabitants of this land, even the kings that sit upon David's throne, and the priests, and the prophets, and all the inhabitants of Jerusalem, with drunkenness. **Jeremiah 13:14** And I will dash them one against another, even the fathers and the sons together, saith the LORD: I will not pity, nor spare, nor have mercy, but destroy them.

Compassionate God – compassionate prophet Jeremiah 13:15 Hear ye, and give ear; be not proud: for the LORD hath spoken.	
Jeremiah 13:16 Give glory to the LORD your God,	before he cause darkness, and before your feet stumble upon the dark mountains, (Pr 4:18-19; 1Pe 2:7-8)
and, while ye look for light,	he turn it into the shadow of death, and make it gross darkness. (Am 4:11-13)
Jeremiah 13:17 But if ye will not hear it,	my soul shall weep in secret places for <i>your</i> pride; and mine eye shall weep sore, and run down with tears, (Ps 119:136)
because the LORD'S flock is carried away captive. (La 3:48)	

Jeremiah 13:18 Say unto the king and to the queen, Humble yourselves, sit down: for your principalities shall come down, *even* the crown of your glory.

Jeremiah 13:19 The cities of the south shall be shut up, and none shall open *them*: Judah shall be carried away captive all of it, it shall be wholly carried away captive.

Jeremiah 13:20 Lift up your eyes, and behold them that come from the north: where *is* the flock *that* was given thee, thy beautiful flock?

Jeremiah 13:21 What wilt thou say when he shall punish thee? for thou hast taught them *to be* captains, *and* as chief over thee: shall not sorrows take thee, as a woman in travail?

Jeremiah 13:22 And if thou say in thine heart, Wherefore come these things upon me? For the greatness of thine iniquity are thy skirts discovered, *and* thy heels made bare. **Jeremiah 13:23** Can the Ethiopian change his skin, or the leopard his spots? *then* may ye also do good, that are accustomed to do evil.

Jeremiah 13:24 Therefore will I scatter them as the stubble that passeth away by the wind of the wilderness.

Jeremiah 13:25 This *is* thy lot, the portion of thy measures from me, saith the LORD;

because thou hast forgotten me, (Eph 1; 2; 3; 4; 5; 6; Col 1; 2; 3)

and trusted in falsehood.

Application:

- 1. unconditional eternal security;
- 2. past, present, future sins forgiven;
- 3. holy walk unnecessary, saved anyway.

Jeremiah 13:26 Therefore will I discover thy skirts upon thy face, that thy shame may appear. **Jeremiah 13:27** I have seen thine adulteries, and thy neighings, the lewdness of thy whoredom, *and* thine abominations on the hills in the fields. Woe unto thee, O Jerusalem! wilt thou not be made clean? when *shall it* once *be*?
