

## BkJer 14. THEY LOVE TO WANDERLightHouse Ranch ChurchJames P. Porteous10-24-21

Jeremiah 14:1 The word of the LORD that came to Jeremiah concerning the dearth. Jeremiah 14:2 Judah mourneth, and the gates thereof languish; they are black unto the ground; and the cry of Jerusalem is gone up.

**Jeremiah 14:3** And their nobles have sent their little ones to the waters: they came to the pits, *and* found no water; they returned with their vessels empty; they were ashamed and confounded, and covered their heads.

Jeremiah 14:4 Because the ground is chapt, for there was no rain in the earth, the plowmen were ashamed, they covered their heads.

**Jeremiah 14:5** Yea, the hind also calved in the field, and forsook *it*, because there was no grass. **Jeremiah 14:6** And the wild asses did stand in the high places, they snuffed up the wind like dragons; their eyes did fail, because *there was* no grass.

## People continually pray the same shallow prayer – they want God's blessing but no mention of returning to Him or following His word

Jeremiah 14:7 O LORD, though our iniquities testify against us, do thou *it* for thy name's sake: for our backslidings are many; we have sinned against thee. Jeremiah 14:8 O the hope of Israel, the saviour thereof in time of trouble, why shouldest thou be as a stranger in the land, and as a wayfaring man *that* turneth aside to tarry for a night? Jeremiah 14:9 Why shouldest thou be as a man astonied, as a mighty man *that* cannot save? yet thou, O LORD, *art* in the midst of us, and we are called by thy name; leave us not.

**Jeremiah 14:10** Thus saith the LORD unto this people, Thus have they loved to wander, they have not refrained their feet, therefore the LORD doth not accept them; he will now remember their iniquity, and visit their sins. (John 3:16-21)

## (love to wander... not refrained their feet... from evil, iniquity)

God's solution: (<u>Jer 6:16-17</u>) Thus saith the LORD, Stand ve in the ways, and see, and ask for the old paths.

where <i>is</i> the good way, and walk therein, ( <u>Ro 8:1-39</u> ) and ye shall find rest for your souls.	But they said, We will not walk therein.
Also I set watchmen over you, <i>saying</i> , Hearken to the sound of the trumpet.	But they said, We will not hearken.
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true watchmen: (<u>Ro 1:16-32</u>; <u>2Timothy 4:1-5</u>): little known fact; the gospel includes walking in the WORD (<u>Titus 2)</u>. **Jeremiah 14:11** Then said the LORD unto me, Pray not for this people for *their* good. **Jeremiah 14:12** When they fast, I will not hear their cry; and when they offer burnt offering and an oblation, I will not accept them: but I will consume them by the sword, and by the famine, and by the pestilence.

Jeremiah 14:13 Then said I, Ah, Lord GOD! behold, the prophets say unto them, Ye shall not see the sword, neither shall ye have famine; but I will give you assured peace in this place. Jeremiah 14:14 Then the LORD said unto me, The prophets prophesy lies in my name: I sent them not, neither have I commanded them, neither spake unto them: they prophesy unto you a false vision and divination, and a thing of nought, and the deceit of their heart. Jeremiah 14:15 Therefore thus saith the LORD concerning the prophets that prophesy in my name, and I sent them not, yet they say, Sword and famine shall not be in this land; By sword and famine shall those prophets be consumed.

**Jeremiah 14:16** And the people to whom they prophesy shall be cast out in the streets of Jerusalem because of the famine and the sword; and they shall have none to bury them, them, their wives, nor their sons, nor their daughters: for I will pour their wickedness upon them.

**Jeremiah 14:17** Therefore thou shalt say this word unto them; Let mine eyes run down with tears night and day, and let them not cease: for the virgin daughter of my people is broken with a great breach, with a very grievous blow.

**Jeremiah 14:18** If I go forth into the field, then behold the slain with the sword! and if I enter into the city, then behold them that are sick with famine! yea, both the prophet and the priest go about into a land that they know not.

Refusing to return to God grieves the LORD and Jeremiah

They just don't get it; *they complain but with no change of heart or ways;* acknowledging sin alone does not remove judgment. Returning to God and following Him and His word removes judgment.

**Jeremiah 14:19** Hast thou utterly rejected Judah? hath thy soul lothed Zion? why hast thou smitten us, and *there is* no healing for us? we looked for peace, and *there is* no good; and for the time of healing, and behold trouble!

**Jeremiah 14:20** We acknowledge, O LORD, our wickedness, *and* the iniquity of our fathers: for we have sinned against thee.

**Jeremiah 14:21** Do not abhor *us*, for thy name's sake, do not disgrace the throne of thy glory: remember, break not thy covenant with us.

**Jeremiah 14:22** Are there *any* among the vanities of the Gentiles that can cause rain? or can the heavens give showers? *art* not thou he, O LORD our God? therefore we will wait upon thee: for thou hast made all these *things*.

## God wants them to change, but they are waiting on Him to change. What must be done to remove judgment? (<u>2Ch 7:13-14</u>)
