Man was created to walk in fellowship with God. (3Jo 4; John 14:6; Re 4:11)

Genesis 3:8 And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden.

God is light and restores fellowship to those who walk in Him.

1 John 1:1 That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled, of the Word of life;

1 John 1:2 (For the life was manifested, and we have seen *it*, and bear witness, and shew unto you that eternal life, which was with the Father, and was manifested unto us;)

1 John 1:3 That which we have seen and heard declare we unto you, that ye also may have fellowship with us: and truly our fellowship *is* with the Father, and with his Son Jesus Christ.

1 John 1:4 And these things write we unto you, that your joy may be full.

1 John 1:5 This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all. (John 1:1-14)

1 John 1:6 If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth:

1 John 1:7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.

God designed restoration before the foundation of the world.

1 Peter 1:18 Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation *received* by tradition from your fathers;
1 Peter 1:19 But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:

1 Peter 1:20 Who verily was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you, (<u>Eph 1:3-6</u>; <u>15-23</u>; <u>Ro 8:29-30</u>)

1 Peter 1:21 Who by him do believe in God, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your faith and hope might be in God.

Judgment and restoration prophesied in Genesis

Genesis 3:14 And the LORD God said unto the serpent, Because thou hast done this, thou *art* cursed above all cattle, and above every beast of the field; upon thy belly shalt thou go, and dust shalt thou eat all the days of thy life:

Genesis 3:15 And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.

Principle I – God is Holy and above Sin – People's reaction in His presence					
A. Adam and Eve removed from garden	Saw cherubim and flaming sword turning everyway (Gen 3:24)				
B. Isaiah in presence of the holy King	Woe is me! I am unclean and have unclean lips (Isa 6:5)				
C. Ezekiel in the presence of God's glory	I fell upon my face (<u>Eze 1:28</u>)				
D. John seeing resurrected Jesus' glory	I Fell down as dead (<u>Re 1:17</u>)

B. Joel's prophecy partially fulfilled in Acts two, and later fulfilled in the Tribulation	Acts 2:14-21; Joel 2:28-31				
C. Rapture & Second Advent in 1 sentence	Titus 2:11-15 – Notice what the Holy Ghost teacheth
