Jeremiah Chapters 37 – 39 Table of Events

- I. Chapter 37
 - 1. Babylonians besiege Jerusalem; Egypt comes to help Judah; Babylonians temporarily leave.
 - 2. Jeremiah prophesy's Babylonians will return and burn the city.
 - 3. Jeremiah is accused of treason and put in prison.
 - 4. King Zedekiah seeks a word from the Lord through Jeremiah.
 - 5. Jeremiah transferred from prison to the court of the prison.

II. Chapter 38

- 1. Jeremiah prophesy's those who remain in the city shall die; those who surrender to the Babylonians shall live.
- 2. King Zedekiah's princes petition him for Jeremiah's death.
- 3. Jeremiah cast into a miry dungeon.
- 4. Ebed-melech asks the king to save Jeremiah from the dungeon.
- 5. Zedekiah again seeks a word from the Lord through Jeremiah.
- 6. Jeremiah repeats the prophecy; stay and die; surrender and live.
- 7. Jeremiah retained again in the court of the prison.

III. Chapter 39

- 1. Jerusalem is taken by the Babylonians.
- 2. King Zedekiah flees by night but is recaptured near Jericho.
- 3. King Nebuchadrezzar kills Zedekiah's sons in front of him, then puts his eyes out and chains him for deportment to Babylon.
- 4. King Nebuchadrezzar tells his captain of the guard to treat Jeremiah kindly and to set him free.
- 5. God gives Jeremiah a prophetic word for Ebed-melech:

Jeremiah 39:16 Go and speak to Ebed-melech the Ethiopian, saying, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will bring my words upon this city for evil, and not for good; and they shall be *accomplished* in that day before thee. Jeremiah 39:17 But I will deliver thee in that day, saith the LORD: and thou shalt not be given into the hand of the men of whom thou *art* afraid.

Jeremiah 39:18 For I will surely deliver thee, and thou shalt not fall by the sword, but thy life shall be for a prey unto thee: because thou hast put thy trust in me, saith the LORD.

IN THAT DAY: the day of the LORD, mentioned twice here. Type: showing that National Israel will go through the Tribulation; but the remnant of Israel will be saved out of it. (<u>Jer 30:7</u>)

ISRAEL SHALL BE SAVED IN THE TRIBULATION PERIOD

Romans 9:27 Esaias also crieth concerning Israel, Though the number of the children of Israel be as the sand of the sea, a remnant shall be saved:

Isaiah 10:20 And it shall come to pass in that day, *that* the remnant of Israel, and such as are escaped of the house of Jacob, shall no more again stay upon him that smote them; but shall stay upon the LORD, the Holy One of Israel, in truth. **Isaiah 10:21** The remnant shall return, *even* the remnant of Jacob, unto the mighty

God.

Isaiah 10:22 For though thy people Israel be as the sand of the sea, *yet* a remnant of them shall return: the consumption decreed shall overflow with righteousness.Isaiah 10:23 For the Lord GOD of hosts shall make a consumption, even determined, in the midst of all the land.
