I. Jeremiah 50

Declare ye among the nations, and publish, and set up a standard; publish, *and* conceal not: say, Babylon is taken, Bel is confounded, Merodach is broken in pieces; her idols are confounded, her images are broken in pieces. **Jeremiah 50:2** (Re 17:5, 18:2-3, 9-11, 18-21)

II. Jeremiah 51

- **1. Eternal truth:** For Israel *hath* not *been* forsaken, nor Judah of his God, of the LORD of hosts; though their land was filled with sin against the Holy One of Israel. **Jeremiah 51:5** (<u>Jer 31:35-37</u>, <u>33:24-26</u>; <u>Ro 11:2-5</u>)
- **2. Warning:** Flee out of the midst of Babylon, and deliver every man his soul: be not cut off in her iniquity; for this *is* the time of the LORD'S vengeance; he will render unto her a recompense. **Jeremiah 51:6**

III. Jeremiah 52

- **1. Review of chapter 39** and additional information regarding the capture of Jerusalem and the captivity of Judah.
- **2. Jehoiachin delivered from prison:** seen as a type pointing to the millennial kingdom of Christ: (Jer 21:9; 2Ki 24:11-15; Jer 52:31-34)
 - a. Evil-merodach king of Babylon: type of Christ (Redeemer),
 - b. Jehoiachin: type of the remnant restoration. (Mt 25:1-30)

The Book of Jeremiah ends its recordings here as an unparalleled and eternal witness to the love and longsuffering of our Creator God and His faithful against all odds servant, Jeremiah.
