Revelation 14:1 And I looked, and, lo, a Lamb stood on the mount Sion, and with him an hundred forty <i>and</i> four thousand, having his Father's name written in their foreheads.	Jesus (Lamb) on heavenly Zion; with Him the 144,000 Jews sealed with the Father's name, the mark of ownership (<u>Re 7:1-8</u>).
Revelation 14:2 And I heard a voice from heaven, as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of a great thunder: and I heard the voice of harpers harping with their harps:	1. many waters: people, nations (<u>17:1</u> , <u>15</u>) 2. great thunder: voice of the most High (<u>2Sa 22:14</u> ; <u>Job 40:9</u> ; <u>Ps 29:3</u> ; <u>Re 4:5</u> ; <u>10:1-6</u> ; <u>19:5-8</u>).
Revelation 14:3 And they sung as it were a new song before the throne, and before the four beasts, and the elders: and no man could learn that song but the hundred <i>and</i> forty <i>and</i> four thousand, which were redeemed from the earth.	No man but the 144,000: another one of the Lamb's (King's) armies separate from the elders (raptured church) because they sing before (in front of and to) the throne, the beasts, and the elders.
Revelation 14:4 These are they which were not defiled with women; for they are virgins. These are they which follow the Lamb whithersoever he goeth. These were redeemed from among men, <i>being</i> the firstfruits unto God and to the Lamb.	 virgins: undefiled, immaculately pure. follow the Lamb: led by Jesus speaks of great activity, witnessing, miracles, revival. redeemed from among men: specifically speaks of salvation of the Jewish people. firstfruits unto God: of national Israel.
Revelation 14:5 And in their mouth was found no guile: for they are without fault before the throne of God.	 no guile: spoke not craftily or deceitful. without fault before the throne of God: they walked fully surrendered to Jesus.
Revelation 14:6 And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people,	 everlasting gospel: the gospel is God's word and as such it is eternal. angel preach: to all people on earth and in all languages; God's wonderful love.

Revelation 14:7 Saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters. Revelation 14:12 Here is the patience of the saints: here <i>are</i> they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus.	 saints: they that keep God's word and the faith OF Jesus; they walk in Christ's faith (Php 2:5) and ways; God's Word in times of unprecedented tribulation. rest: (awaiting the kingdom) and their WORKS do follow them; assuring them of great glory and special recognition when Christ sets up the eternal kingdom of God (Re 20:4).
Revelation 14:13 And I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Write, Blessed <i>are</i> the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth: Yea, saith the Spirit, that they may rest from their labours; and their works do follow them.	
Revelation 14:14 And I looked, and behold a white cloud, and upon the cloud <i>one</i> sat like unto the Son of man, having on his head a golden crown, and in his hand a sharp sickle.	Jesus Christ, Son of man, Lamb slain from the foundation of the world, Lion of the tribe of Judah, King of kings, Word of God leads the regiment of angels in the final harvest of the fierce wrath of Almighty God.

 Revelation 14:15 And another angel came out of the temple, crying with a loud voice to him that sat on the cloud, Thrust in thy sickle, and reap: for the time is come for thee to reap; for the harvest of the earth is ripe. Revelation 14:16 And he that sat on the cloud thrust in his sickle on the earth; and the earth was reaped. 	reap: the message of the angel out of the temple is from the Father telling the Son to reap the ripe harvest of the earth; it is time to fulfill all the prophecies of Daniel's 70 th week and of the other holy prophets and to end the time of the Gentiles; it is time to prepare for the glorious return of Christ to the earth and the inauguration of the great millennial kingdom of God on earth.	
 Revelation 14:17 And another angel came out of the temple which is in heaven, he also having a sharp sickle. Revelation 14:18 And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth; for her grapes are fully ripe. 	 another angel from the temple in heaven represents the invisible Holy Spirit who performs all the works of God (<u>Isa 4:2-6;</u> <u>Mic 3:8; Mt 12:28; Zec 4:6</u>). power over fire: the purifying, cleansing work of the Holy Spirit (<u>1Co 6:9-11; John 6:63; 15:1-6</u>). 	
Revelation 14:19 And the angel thrust in his sickle into the earth, and gathered the vine of the earth, and cast <i>it</i> into the great winepress of the wrath of God.	vine of the earth: fruit of the fallen world; evil systems, doctrines, philosophies, works, religions, wickedness (<u>1Jo 5:18-19</u>).	
Revelation 14:20 And the winepress was trodden without the city, and blood came out of the winepress, even unto the horse bridles, by the space of a thousand <i>and</i> six hundred furlongs.	1. blood winepress: Christ treads the winepress alone outside the city (<u>Isa 63:1-4</u> ; <u>Eze 39:17-22</u> ; <u>Heb 13:11-13</u>).
