Sure Victory Over the Enemy – but you don't win unless you fight, lawfully (2Ti 2:5)! Because thou hast kept the word of my patience, I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation,

Scripture	Notes					
Revelation 15:1 And I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvellous, seven angels having the seven last plagues; for in them is filled up the wrath of God.	In them is filled up the wrath of God: vision and prophecy that through the 7 last plagues the full wrath of God will be fulfilled (Re 10:7; 11:15).					
Revelation 15:2 And I saw as it were a sea of glass mingled with fire: and them that had gotten the victory over the beast, and over his image, and over his mark, and over the number of his name, stand on the sea of glass, having the harps of God.	Sea of glass, before the throne: (Re 4:4-8). Mingled with fire: signifying the purifying work of the Holy Spirit: (Mt 3:11; 1Pe 1:3-9; 4:12-14). Victory over antichrist: (Re 12:11; 6:9-11; 20:4).					
Revelation 15:3 And they sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, Great and marvellous <i>are</i> thy works, Lord God Almighty; just and true <i>are</i> thy ways, thou King of saints.	Songs of Victory Song of Moses: free from bondage (Ex 15:1-18). Song of the Lamb: only through the Lamb are we victorious over the devil & antichrist (Re 5:6-14).					
Revelation 15:4 Who shall not fear thee, O Lord, and glorify thy name? for <i>thou</i> only <i>art</i> holy: for all nations shall come and worship before thee; for thy judgments are made manifest.	The song continues: but also prophesying that nations will come and worship before God in the millennial kingdom (Ps 22:27; 86:9; Zec 14:16).					
Revelation 15:5 And after that I looked, and, behold, the temple of the tabernacle of the testimony in heaven was opened:	The temple of the tabernacle of the testimony: (Ex 27:21; 30:26; 30:34-36; 40:5; 21; Nu 7:89). Temple NT: (Mk 13:1; John 2:15; Ac 21:30).					
Revelation 15:6 And the seven angels came out of the temple, having the seven plagues, clothed in pure and white linen, and having their breasts girded with golden girdles.	Seven angels came out of the temple: White linen: righteousness (Re 19:6-8). Golden girdles: (Re 1:13).					
Revelation 15:7 And one of the four beasts gave unto the seven angels seven golden vials full of the wrath of God, who liveth for ever and ever.	Wrath of God: (Re 14:9-10; John 3:36; Ro 1:16- 18; Eph 5:1-7; Col 3:1-17).					
Revelation 15:8 And the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God, and from his power; and no man was able to enter into the temple, till the seven plagues of the seven angels were fulfilled.	1. Smoke, glory, power: God's presence (<u>Isa</u> 6:1-4; 1Ch 29:9-11; Ps 145:9-13; Mt 6:13; 24:30). 2. Temple closed: no mercy, but praise God the temple is still open today (<u>Mk 15:37</u> ; <u>Heb 4:14-16</u>). 3. Properly identify your enemy (<u>Eph 6:12</u>); being obedient and in full armor with your sharp Sword (<u>Eph 6:17</u>), you fight; persevere, and win; you sing <u>YOUR</u> song like king David (<u>2Sa 22:1-51</u>).
