Proverbs 30:5 Every word of God *is* pure: he *is* a shield unto them that put their trust in him.

Revelation 16:1 And I heard a great voice out of the temple saying to the seven angels, Go your ways, and pour out the vials of the wrath of God upon the earth.	 voice out of the temple: 7 angels (out of the temple, <u>Re 15:6</u>).
Revelation 16:2 And the first went, and poured out his vial upon the earth; and there fell a noisome and grievous sore upon the men which had the mark of the beast, and <i>upon</i> them which worshipped his image.	grievous sore: similar 6 th Egyptian Plague – Boils (<u>Exodus 9:8-11</u>); 1 st vial fulfills (<u>Re 14:9-10</u>).
 Revelation 16:3 And the second angel poured out his vial upon the sea; and it became as the blood of a dead <i>man</i>: and every living soul died in the sea. Revelation 16:4 And the third angel poured out his vial upon the rivers and fountains of waters; and they became blood. 	blood / waters: similar 1 st Egyptian Plague – Nile turned to blood (Exodus 7:9-24).
Revelation 16:5 And I heard the angel of the waters say, Thou art righteous, O Lord, which art, and wast, and shalt be, because thou hast judged thus. Revelation 16:6 For they have shed the blood of saints and prophets, and thou hast given them blood to drink; for they are worthy.	Thou art righteous, O Lord because thou hast judged thus: (<u>Ga 6:7-8</u>).
Revelation 16:7 And I heard another out of the altar say, Even so, Lord God Almighty, true and righteous <i>are</i> thy judgments.	heard out of the altar say Lord God Almighty, true and righteous are thy judgments: martyred saints are under the altar of incense (<u>Re 6:9-11</u> ; <u>Mt 23:33-35</u>).

 Revelation 16:8 And the fourth angel poured out his vial upon the sun; and power was given unto him to scorch men with fire. Revelation 16:9 And men were scorched with great heat, and blasphemed the name of God, which hath power over these plagues: and they repented not to give him glory. 	Scorched with great heat: (Isa 30:26-30). damnation for those that blaspheme, refuse to repent, and do not love the truth (<u>2Th 2:8-12</u>).
Revelation 16:10 And the fifth angel poured out his vial upon the seat of the beast; and his kingdom was full of darkness; and they gnawed their tongues for pain, Revelation 16:11 And blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores, and repented not of their deeds.	darkness: similar 9 th Egyptian Plague – (<u>Exodus 10:21-23</u>).
Revelation 16:12 And the sixth angel poured out his vial upon the great river Euphrates; and the water thereof was dried up, that the way of the kings of the east might be prepared.	way of the kings: prophesied (<u>Isa 19:23</u>).
Revelation 16:13 And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs <i>come</i> out of the mouth of the dragon, and out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet. Revelation 16:14 For they are the spirits	
of devils, working miracles, <i>which</i> go forth unto the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty.	frogs: similar to the 2 nd Egyptian plague (<u>Ex 8:1-6</u>). spirits of devils: (<u>Mk 13:22-23; 1Ti 4:1-2;</u> <u>2Ti 3:1-6; 2Pe 2:1-3; 1Jo 4:1-3</u>).
Revelation 16:15 Behold, I come as a thief. Blessed <i>is</i> he that watcheth, and keepeth his garments, lest he walk naked, and they see his shame.	1. come as a thief: rapture (<u>Mk 13:30-33</u>). 2. not as a thief: 2 nd Advent (<u>Mt 24:29-30</u>). 3. watcheth and keepeth his garments: robe of righteousness (<u>Mic 6:8; John 8:12;</u> <u>Ga 5:16-17; Eph 5:11-17; Php 3:17-21;</u> <u>Col 1:10-23; 1Th 2:12; 4:1; 2Th 3:6; 1Jo</u> <u>1:5-7; 3:7; 3:10; 5:18-20; Jude 17-21</u>).
Revelation 16:16 And he gathered them together into a place called in the Hebrew tongue Armageddon.	Armageddon: (<u>Joel 3:1-2;</u> <u>11-17;</u> <u>Zec 12:1-9</u> ; <u>Re 19:11-21</u>).

Revelation 16:18 And there were voices, and thunders, and lightnings; and there was a great earthquake, such as was not since men were upon the earth, so mighty an earthquake, <i>and</i> so great.	 voices, thunders, lightnings, earthquake: also in the 7th seal (<u>Re 8:5</u>); and voices in the 7th trumpet (<u>Re 11:15</u>); (<u>Re 8:3-5; 11:19</u>; <u>Isa 66:5-6</u>); greatest earthquake: foretold (Zec 14:1-5);
Revelation 16:19 And the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell: and great Babylon came in remembrance before God, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath.	 greatest ever, level mtns, destroy islands; divides the "great city" in 3 prts (<u>Re 17:18</u>); cities of other nations fall. 2. "grt Babylon" in remembrance b4 God: all evil and rebelliousness against God, to be destroyed by God's fierce wrath.
Revelation 16:20 And every island fled away, and the mountains were not found.	prophesied: (<u>Isa 42:13-16</u>).
Revelation 16:21 And there fell upon men	hail: similar 7th Egyptian Plague – Hail

Psalm 9:8 And he shall judge the world in righteousness, he shall minister judgment to the people in uprightness.

Psalm 119:160 Thy word *is* true *from* the beginning: and every one of thy righteous judgments *endureth* for ever.
