| Re 20:2 And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years,  | Halleluiah, praise God for His faithfulness to fulfill all His word: <u>Isa</u> 65:25; 35:4-10.  |
| Re 20:3 And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season.  | Halleluiah, no devil to tempt and deceive us during the millennial reign of Christ: <u>Isa 11:1-10</u> ; <u>32:1</u> ; <u>Jer 33:14-16</u> .   |

## AFTER THE DEVIL IS CAST INTO THE LAKE OF FIRE

Re 20:11 And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.

Re 20:12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is *the book* of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.

Re 20:13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works.

Re 20:14 And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. Re 20:15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.
