(2Pe 2:3) And through covetousness shall they with feigned words make merchandise of you: whose judgment now of a long time lingereth not, and their damnation slumbereth not.

Smyrna Persecuted Rev 2:8-11	Materially poor but rich in God, enduring many fiery trials, humbly serving, and powerful in the Holy Spirit amongst false brethren	(Rev 2:10) Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life. Pergamos Spiritual fornication Rev 2:12- 17	Freedom gospel – anything goes, lured by the world, hired preachers for gain, disobedient, immoral, separatist teaching.	(Rev 2:16) Repent; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will fight against them with the sword of my mouth. Thyratira Careless Rev 2:18- 29	False prophets and teachers, seducing messages, tolerating immorality and disobedience but also those who do not subscribe to the church's evil practices	(Rev_2:22-23) Great tribulation to those who do not repent (Rev_2:24-25) To the faithful hold fast till I come	(2Ti_3:5), (Rom_6:16), (Jer_5:21-23), (Eze_13:3), (Mat_7:26-27), (Mat_25:8-9), (Rom_1:21), (Gal_3:1)
Sardis Dead Rev 3:1-6	Spiritually dead, without the Holy Spirit, worldwide religious appeal, empty ceremonies, no deliverances, take liberties with the Word of God, pagan practices, idol worship	(Rev 3:3) Remember therefore how thou hast received and heard, and hold fast, and repent. If therefore thou shalt not watch, I will come on thee as a thief, and thou shalt not know what hour I will come upon thee. Philadelphia Revived Rev 3:7-13	(Rev 3:8) I know thy works: behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it: for thou hast a little strength, and hast kept my word, and hast not denied my name.	(Rev 3:11) Behold, I come quickly: hold that fast which thou hast, that no man take thy crown.	(Rev_3:10), (1Th_5:21), (2Ti_1:13), (Heb_3:6), (Heb_4:14), (Heb_10:23-27)
Laodicea Lukewarm Rev 3:14- 22	(Rev_3:15-16), (Rev 3:17) Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked:	(Rev 3:18) I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see.
