



In John's day: 1 st 5 fallen; Rome still is; revised Rome is the 7 th and is not yet; Antichrist himself (beast) is called the 8 th king, Rev 17:8-11 king of revised Rome									

- 1. Israel has her spiritual blinders removed and is saved, <u>Isa 45:17-19</u>; <u>Rom 11:25-28</u>; <u>Re 14:1-4</u>
- 2. The Antichrist and his kingdom are destroyed by Jesus Christ, the King of Kings
- 3. The Lamb slain from the foundation of the world is given an everlasting kingdom

God Gives Daniel the Interpretation of the Dream

Daniel 2:32-33 This image's head *was* of fine gold, his breast and his arms of silver, his belly and his thighs of brass, His legs of iron, his feet part of iron and part of clay.

Daniel 2:38 And wheresoever the children of men dwell, the beasts of the field and the fowls of the heaven hath he given into thine hand, and hath made thee ruler over them all. Thou *art* this head of gold.

Daniel 2:39 And after thee shall arise another kingdom inferior to thee, and another third kingdom of brass, which shall bear rule over all the earth.

Daniel 2:40 And the fourth kingdom shall be strong as iron: forasmuch as iron breaketh in pieces and subdueth all *things*: and as iron that breaketh all these, shall it break in pieces and bruise.

Daniel 2:41 And whereas thou sawest the feet and toes, part of potters' clay, and part of iron, the kingdom shall be divided; but there shall be in it of the strength of the iron, forasmuch as thou sawest the iron mixed with miry clay.

Daniel 2:42 And *as* the toes of the feet *were* part of iron, and part of clay, *so* the kingdom shall be partly strong, and partly broken.
