

BkEze 13 WOE UNTO THE FOOLISH PROPHETS – GOD ANOINTS TRUE PROPHETSText: Ezekiel 13LightHouse Ranch ChurchJames P. Porteous05-07-23

TWISTING, ALTERING, DENYING GOD'S WORD – God's Word is THE GOSPEL



Eze 13:1 And the word of the LORD came unto me, saying, Eze 13:2 Son of man, prophesy against the prophets of Israel that prophesy, and <u>say thou unto them that prophesy</u> <u>out of their own hearts, Hear ye the word of the LORD;</u> Eze 13:3 Thus saith the Lord GOD; Woe unto the foolish prophets, that <u>follow their own spirit</u>, and have seen nothing! Eze 13:8 Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Because ye have spoken vanity, and seen lies, therefore, behold, I *am* against you, saith the Lord GOD. Eze 13:9 And mine hand shall be upon the prophets that


see vanity, and that divine lies: they shall not be in the assembly of my people, neither shall they be written in the writing of the house of Israel, neither shall they enter into the land of Israel; and ye shall know that I am the Lord GOD.

COULD THE ABOVE PROPHECY BE ANY PLAINER? (Jer 23:21-22; 1Co 2:12-14)

Eze 13:10 Because, even because they have seduced my people, saying, Peace; and

there was no peace; and one built up a wall, and, lo, others daubed it with untempered *morter*.

Eze 13:11 Say unto them which daub *it* with untempered *morter*, that it shall fall: there shall be an overflowing shower; and ye, O great hailstones, shall fall; and a stormy wind shall rend *it*.



Eze 13:12 Lo, when the wall is fallen, shall it not be said unto you, Where *is* the daubing wherewith ye have daubed *it*?

Eze 13:13 Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; <u>I will even rend *it*</u> with a stormy wind in my fury; and there shall be an overflowing shower <u>in mine anger</u>, and great hailstones in *my* fury to consume *it*.

Eze 13:14 So will I break down the wall that ye have daubed with untempered *morter*, and bring it down to the ground, so that the foundation thereof shall be discovered, and it shall fall, and ye shall be consumed in the midst thereof: and ye shall know that I *am* the LORD.

Eze 13:15 Thus will I accomplish my wrath upon the wall, and upon them that have daubed it with untempered morter, and will say unto you, The wall is no more, neither they that daubed it;

Eze 13:16 *To wit*, the prophets of Israel which prophesy concerning Jerusalem, and which see visions of peace for her, and *there is* no peace, saith the Lord GOD.

Eze 13:17 Likewise, thou son of man, set thy face against the daughters of thy people, which prophesy out of their own heart; and prophesy thou against them,

Eze 13:18 And say, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Woe to the *women* that sew pillows to all armholes, and make kerchiefs upon the head of every stature to hunt souls! Will ye hunt the souls



of my people, and will ye save the souls alive *that come* unto you? **Eze 13:19** And <u>will ye pollute me among my people</u> for handfuls of barley and for pieces of bread, to slay the souls that should not die, and to save the souls alive that should not live, by your lying to my people that hear *your* lies?

Eze 13:20 Wherefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I *am* against your pillows, wherewith ye there hunt the souls to make *them* fly, and I will tear them from your arms, and will let the souls go, *even* the souls that ye hunt to make *them* fly.

(<u>remnant Jews saved in the tribulation; serve Christ in the kingdom</u> Jer 30:7-9) **Eze 13:21** Your kerchiefs also <u>will I tear, and deliver my people out of your hand</u>, and they shall be no more in your hand to be hunted; and ye shall know that I *am* the LORD. (**How?** <u>God's people Living the Gospel–God's Word)</u>

(Ro 5:8-10 saved by His life; John 1:12-13; 1Peter 1:23)

Eze 13:22 Because with lies ye have made the heart of the righteous sad, whom I have not made sad; and strengthened the hands of the wicked, that he should not return from his wicked way, by promising him life: (lie: <u>unconditional</u> eternal salvation)

Heb 5:8 Though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered; Heb 5:9 And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation

unto all them that obey him;

(<u>1Jo 2:3-6,28-29; 3:7-10; 5:18</u>)

Eze 13:23 Therefore ye shall see no more vanity, nor divine divinations: for <u>I will</u> deliver my people out of your hand: and ye shall know that I am the LORD.

Deliverance – obedience to the faith, <u>Romans 1:1-17</u> **Bondage and death** – disobedience, rebellion, <u>Romans 1:18-32</u>
