

Ezekiel 19 THIS IS AND SHALL BE FOR A LAMENTATION LightHouse Ranch Biblical Chuckwagon – *come and dine* 06-18-23

Are Israeli kings censored from the throne of David?

Thus saith the Lord GOD; Remove the diadem, and take off the crown: this *shall* not *be* the same: exalt *him that is* low, and abase *him that is* high. <u>I will overturn, overturn, it: and it shall be no *more*, until he come whose right it is; and I will give it *him*. **Ezekiel 21:26-27** (Isaiah 11)</u>

Ezekiel 19:1 (KJB) Moreover take thou up a lamentation for the princes of Israel,
2 And say, What *is* thy mother? A lioness: she lay down among lions, she nourished her whelps among young lions. (Israel: whores with pagans; raises sons in pagan ways)
3 And she brought up one of her whelps: it became a young lion, and it learned to catch the prey; it devoured men.

4 The nations also heard of him; he was taken in their pit, and they brought him with chains unto the land of Egypt. (<u>2Chronicles 36:1-4</u>)

5 Now when she saw that she had waited, *and* her hope was lost, then she took another of her whelps, *and* made him a young lion.

6 And he went up and down among the lions, he became a young lion, and learned to catch the prey, *and* devoured men. (<u>2Chronicles 36:5-6</u>)

7 And he knew their desolate palaces, and he laid waste their cities; and the land was desolate, and the fulness thereof, by the noise of his roaring.

8 Then the nations set against him on every side from the provinces, and spread their net over him: he was taken in their pit. (<u>2Kings 23:1-6</u>)

9 And they put him in ward in chains, and brought him to the king of Babylon: they brought him into holds, that his voice should no more be heard upon the mountains of Israel. (Jeremiah 22:28-30; Ezekiel 43:7; king Zedekiah also, 2Kings 25:6-7)
10 Thy mother *is* like a vine in thy blood, planted by the waters: she was fruitful and full of

branches by reason of many waters (**Israel: by many cleansings "God's grace" was fruitful**). **11** And she had strong rods for the sceptres of them that bare rule, and her stature was exalted among the thick branches, and she appeared in her height with the multitude of

her branches (following kings ruling by the sceptre of God's Word she was exalted).

12 But she was plucked up in fury (**God's**), she was cast down to the ground, and the east wind dried up her fruit: her strong rods were broken and withered; the fire consumed them.

13 And now she *is* planted in the wilderness, in a dry and thirsty ground. (**bondage**) **14** And fire is gone out of a rod of her branches, *which* hath devoured her fruit, so that she hath no strong rod *to be* a sceptre to rule (**no righteous king**). This *is* a lamentation, and shall be for a lamentation. (<u>until he come whose right it is; and I will give it *him*, Eze 21:27</u>)
