Important facts necessary in understanding this chapter

*National Israel has been under double judgment;

why? (Isaiah 40:1-5).

*The LORD provides the way to escape condemnation;

how? (Deuteronomy 18:9-19; Acts 7:37-38; Revelation 3:10-12).

*Israel from darkness to glorious liberty;

when? The Day of the LORD! (Joel 2:1-32; Acts 2:1- "14-21" -43; 3:11-23).

*Israeli and Gentile remnants in the Tribulation;

how? (Revelation 7; 14:1-5).

*Israel in the kingdom

(Isaiah 2:2-5; Daniel 2:44-45; 12:1-3; Zechariah 12:8-10)

*Christ instructs Israel to flee Jerusalem (Matthew 24:1- "15-22" -51); where, do they go? (Daniel 11:41).

Israel comes Alive!

Ezekiel 37:1 (KJB) The hand of the LORD was upon me, and carried me out in the spirit of the LORD, and set me down in the midst of the valley which *was* full of bones, **2** And caused me to pass by them round about: and, behold, *there were* very many in the open valley; and, lo, *they were* very dry.

- **3** And he said unto me, Son of man, can these bones live? And I answered, O Lord GOD, thou knowest.
- **4** Again he said unto me, Prophesy upon these bones, and say unto them, O ye dry bones, hear the word of the LORD.
- **5** Thus saith the Lord GOD unto these bones; Behold, I will cause breath to enter into you, and ye shall live:
- **6** And I will lay sinews upon you, and will bring up flesh upon you, and cover you with skin, and put breath in you, and ye shall live; and ye shall know that I *am* the LORD.
- **7** So I prophesied as I was commanded: and as I prophesied, there was a noise, and behold a shaking, and the bones came together, bone to his bone.
- **8** And when I beheld, lo, the sinews and the flesh came up upon them, and the skin covered them above: but *there was* no breath in them.
- **9** Then said he unto me, Prophesy unto the wind, prophesy, son of man, and say to the wind, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Come from the four winds, O breath, and breathe upon these slain, that they may live.
- 10 So I prophesied as he commanded me, and the breath came into them, and they lived, and stood up upon their feet, an exceeding great army.

- **11** Then he said unto me, Son of man, these bones are the whole house of Israel: behold, they say, Our bones are dried, and our hope is lost: we are cut off for our parts.
- **12** Therefore prophesy and say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, O my people, I will open your graves, and cause you to come up out of your graves, and bring you into the land of Israel.
- **13** And ye shall know that I *am* the LORD, when I have opened your graves, O my people, and brought you up out of your graves,
- **14** And shall put my spirit in you, and ye shall live, and I shall place you in your own land: then shall ye know that I the LORD have spoken *it*, and performed *it*, saith the LORD.
- 15 The word of the LORD came again unto me, saying,
- **16** Moreover, thou son of man, take thee one stick, and write upon it, For Judah, and for the children of Israel his companions: then take another stick, and write upon it, For Joseph, the stick of Ephraim, and *for* all the house of Israel his companions:
- **17** And join them one to another into one stick; and they shall become one in thine hand.
- **18** And when the children of thy people shall speak unto thee, saying, Wilt thou not shew us what thou *meanest* by these?
- **19** Say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I will take the stick of Joseph, which *is* in the hand of Ephraim, and the tribes of Israel his fellows, and will put them with him, *even* with the stick of Judah, and make them one stick, and they shall be one in mine hand.
- **20** And the sticks whereon thou writest shall be in thine hand before their eyes.
- **21** And say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I will take the children of Israel from among the heathen, whither they be gone, and will gather them on every side, and bring them into their own land:
- **22** And I will make them one nation in the land upon the mountains of Israel; and one king shall be king to them all: and they shall be no more two nations, neither shall they be divided into two kingdoms any more at all:
- 23 Neither shall they defile themselves any more with their idols, nor with their detestable things, nor with any of their transgressions: but I will save them out of all their dwellingplaces, wherein they have sinned, and will cleanse them: so shall they be my people, and I will be their God.
- **24** And David my servant *shall be* king over them; and they all shall have one shepherd: they shall also walk in my judgments, and observe my statutes, and do them.
- **25** And they shall dwell in the land that I have given unto Jacob my servant, wherein your fathers have dwelt; and they shall dwell therein, *even* they, and their children, and their children for ever: and my servant David *shall be* their prince for ever.
- **26** Moreover I will make a covenant of peace with them; it shall be an everlasting covenant with them: and I will place them, and multiply them, and will set my sanctuary in the midst of them for evermore.
- 27 My tabernacle also shall be with them: yea, I will be their God, and they shall be my people.
