LIFE IN THE SPIRIT - REVEALS CHRIST—IN YOU

(Col 1:26) Even the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest to his saints: (Col 1:27) To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory:

(Col 1:28) Whom we preach, warning every man, and teaching every man in all wisdom; that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus:

YOUR LIFE IS HID WITH CHRIST IN GOD

(Col 3:1) If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God. (Col 3:2) Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth.

(Col 3:3) For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God.

(Col 3:4) When Christ, who is our life, shall appear, then shall ye also appear with him in glory.

GOD'S PLAN SANCTIFIES—YOU

(Col 3:5) Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth; fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry: (Col 3:6) For which things' sake the wrath of God cometh on the children of disobedience:

(Col 3:7) In the which ye also walked some time, when ye lived in them.

(Col 3:8) But now ye also put off all these; anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy communication out of your mouth.

(Col 3:9) Lie not one to another, seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds;

(Col 3:10) And have put on the new man, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him:

HOLY GHOST CLOTHING—REVEALED

(2Co 5:1) For we know that if our earthly house of this tabernacle were dissolved, we have a building of God, an house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens.

(2Co 5:2) For in this we groan, earnestly desiring to be clothed upon with our house which is from heaven:

(2Co 5:3) If so be that being clothed we shall not be found naked.

(2Co 5:4) For we that are in this tabernacle do groan, being burdened: not for that we would be unclothed, but clothed upon, that mortality might be swallowed up of life. (2Co 5:5) Now he that hath wrought us for the selfsame thing is God, who also hath given unto us the earnest of the Spirit.

CONFIDENT—BOLD, COURAGIOUS, AND JOYFULL

(2Co 5:6) Therefore we are always confident, knowing that, whilst we are at home in the body, we are absent from the Lord:

(2Co 5:7) (For we walk by faith, not by sight:)

(2Co 5:8) We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.

(2Co 5:9) Wherefore we labour, that, whether present or absent, we may be accepted of him.

(2Co 5:10) For we must all appear before the judgment

seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad.

(2Co 5:11) Knowing therefore the terror of the Lord, we persuade men; but we are made manifest unto God; and I trust also are made manifest in your consciences.

(2Co 6:1) We then, as workers together with him, beseech you also that we receive not the grace of God in vain.

MORTALITY SWALLOWED UP OF LIFE

(2Ti 1:8) Be not thou therefore ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me his prisoner; but be thou partaker of the afflictions of the gospel according to the power of God; (2Ti 1:9) Who hath saved us, and called us with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began,

(2Ti 1:10) But is now made manifest by the appearing of our Saviour Jesus Christ, who hath abolished death, and hath brought life and immortality to light through the gospel:

GOD'S PLAN TRANSFORMS AND RENEWS YOUR MIND

(Rom 12:1) I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

(Rom 12:2) And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

MIGHTY SPIRITUAL WEAPONS - THE BLOOD AND NAME OF CHRIST, THE WORD OF GOD, THE HOLY SPIRIT BAPTISM, GOD HIMSELF, GOD ALMIGHTY IN YOU—HALLELUJAH!

(2Co 10:4) (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) (2Co 10:5) Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

(2Co 10:6) And having in a readiness to revenge all disobedience, when your obedience is fulfilled.

(Php 2:5) Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:

(Php 2:6) Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:

(Php 2:7) But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the <u>likeness of men:</u>

(Php 2:8) And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

(Act 1:8) But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

(Rev 12:10) And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.

(Rev 12:11) And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.
